The Adventure Golf att Golfanlagen Hohenhardter Hof was built up a steep hill. This has given it a very unique design, where the slope is used in several holes. As a bonus, you get a great view of the large golf course when you reach the middle of the game.

Travel back hundreds of years in time and you end up in the Middle Ages. This theme is clearly featured at Adventure Golf Hohenhardt, where knights coincide with castles, moats and armbrushes.

Immediately when the player enters the facility, they are welcomed by a knight in shining armor. His sword, however, is stuck in a rock on the first hole.

The game goes on and we pass bears, armbrushes, a big sun clock and a stock before we reach the smith. Here, the ball has to pass past the anvil in the middle of the faiway and a photo spot where you can take pictures as the smith's family. The game carries on over water and bridges.

On an island in the water is a model of a local castle. To get over, the ball is played over the drawbridge. Last at the Adventure Golf, a throne is waiting for the one in the company that won the game.
